- have problems at preschool/childcare
- hurt themselves or others (hitting, biting, etc.)
- have trouble calming down
- have severe temper tantrums
- cry uncontrollably

ARE YOU...

- tired all the time
- missing appointments
- not interested in playing, interacting with your child
- nervous, stressed, worried
- overwhelmed
- concerned about changes in your child's behavior

Many of these behaviors are normal. When the behavior becomes frequent and/or difficult to cope with your daily life, this is a concern. Providing emotional support and teaching children how to express and control their feelings can prevent these problems from getting worse.

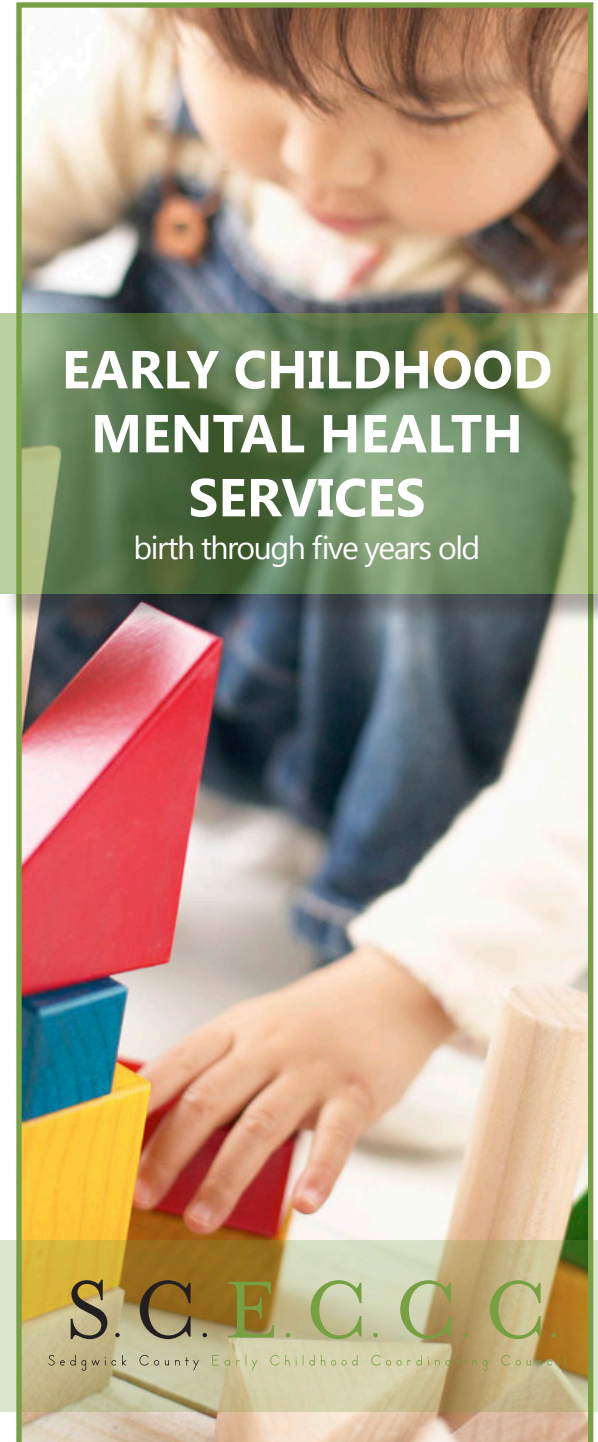
