Part C Update - Paco

- We got our review back from the state on our Semi-Annual Report. Our only additional requirement is to develop a plan to recruit more parents for the SCECCC. We discussed some parent possibilities.
- We got our request for our State Annual IFSP Review. We had 48 hours to put together and send in. We did send it in at 26 hours. There will be more IFSPs that we will have to send in later with a Quality Indicator Rubric.
- We had a new Physical Therapist start this week.

- \$11,500 raised from the Connecting Point Golf Tournament. The Group is talking about doing it again next year.
- Cayla has been working with Shannon Benoit from USD 259 on the Screen for Success. Shannon now is the supervisor for the screening.

Task Group Updates - Michelle

June suggested having a panel to talk about behavioral panel either for the Home Visitation training items or for the SCECCC Full Council

Lunch and Learn is working on another Trauma informed Yoga training. They will be setting up another meeting date for the task group.

Michelle and others have gone through a Train the Trainer for Dual Diagnosis. Working with individual that are IDD and with mental health issues. Michelle is one of the trainers in the Community along with Audra Kenneson from Rainbows Mental Health. Everyone gets a full workbook with all ten sections of the possible training. We could possibly work this into a training that we offer.

Fatherhood group met 9/18/17. The group was looking at what are the changes that the group will need to make to meet new grant requirements. They will look at developing three focuses, Events,

community public informational campaign, intentional fatherhood promotional changes in a specific organization.

June asked how the “Watch Dog” program that is being implemented in some elementary schools, could be adapted to more early childhood centers.
